Twenty watermelon shapes: ten with the numbers and ten with the seeds

- Skills worked on

- Observation and counting


Touch two watermelon pieces: one with seeds, another with numbers. Read the numbers on each half to your teacher.


Connect the watermelon pieces of equal value as if they were a puzzle.


Check the work done with your teacher!

Put the halves of the watermelon in order from 1 to 10 and, using real seeds (beans or lentils for example), group the right number of seeds for each half.
