Counting to 10, putting numbers in the right order, evaluating quantities

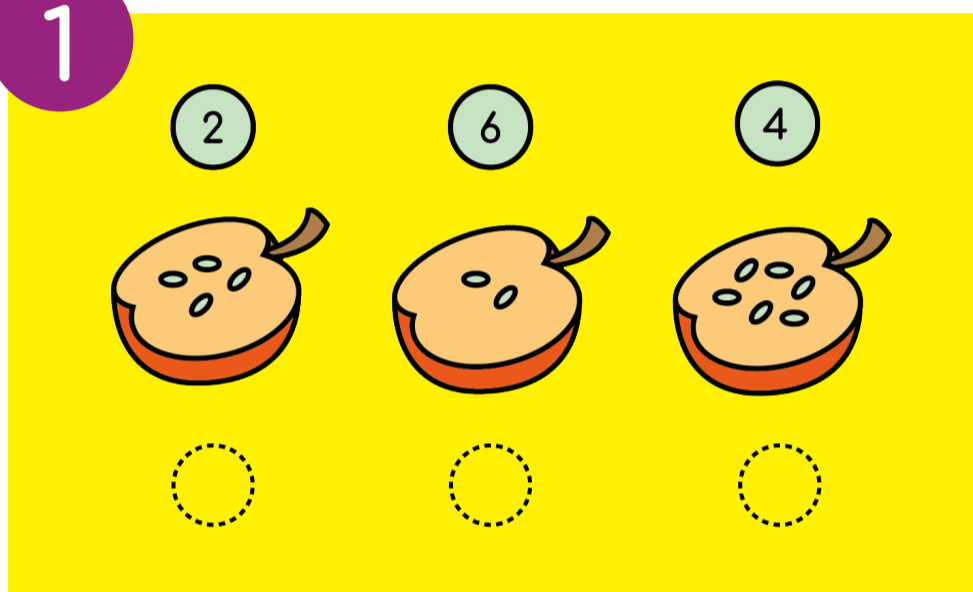

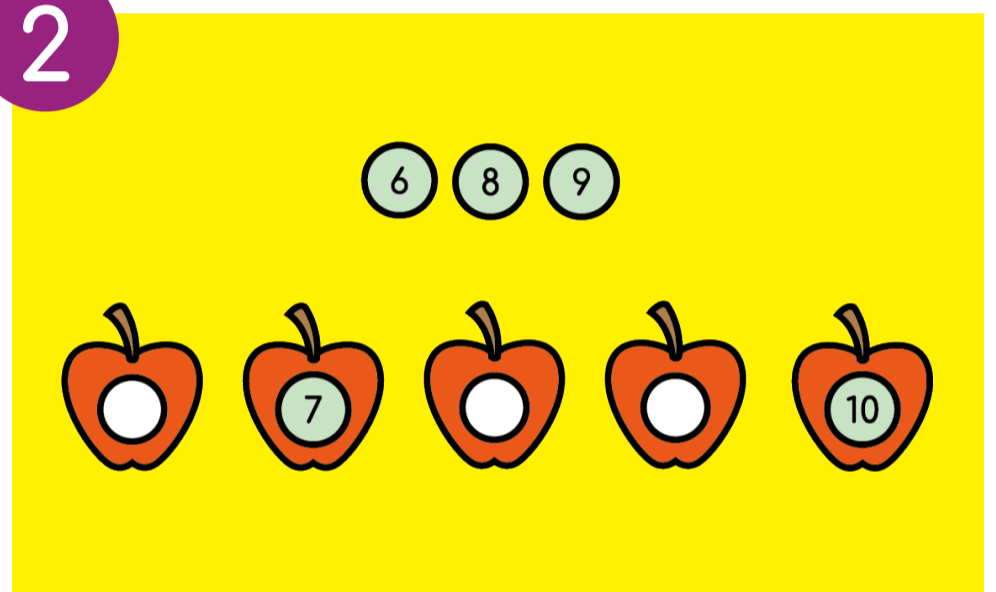

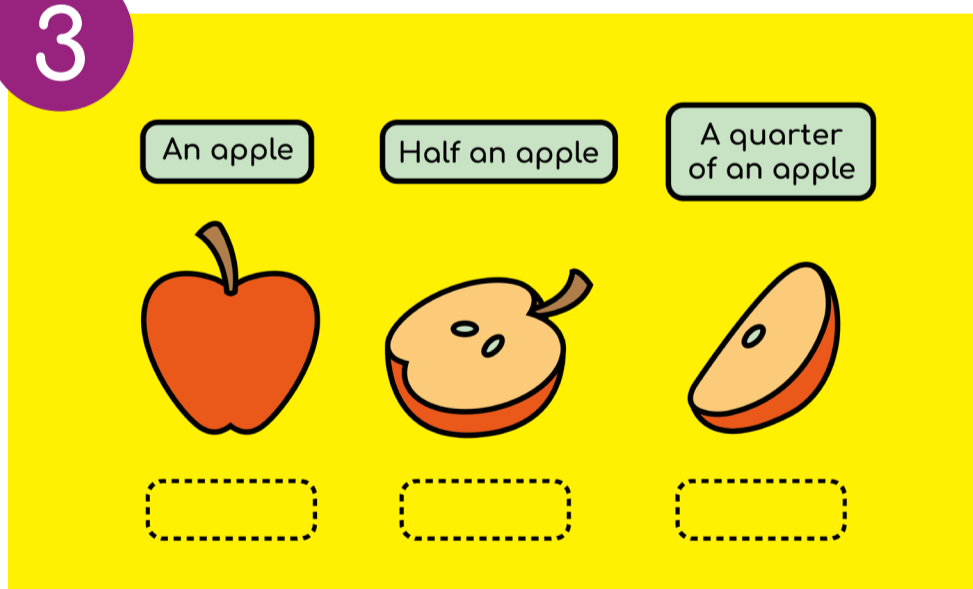
Count the number of seeds in each apple.

2



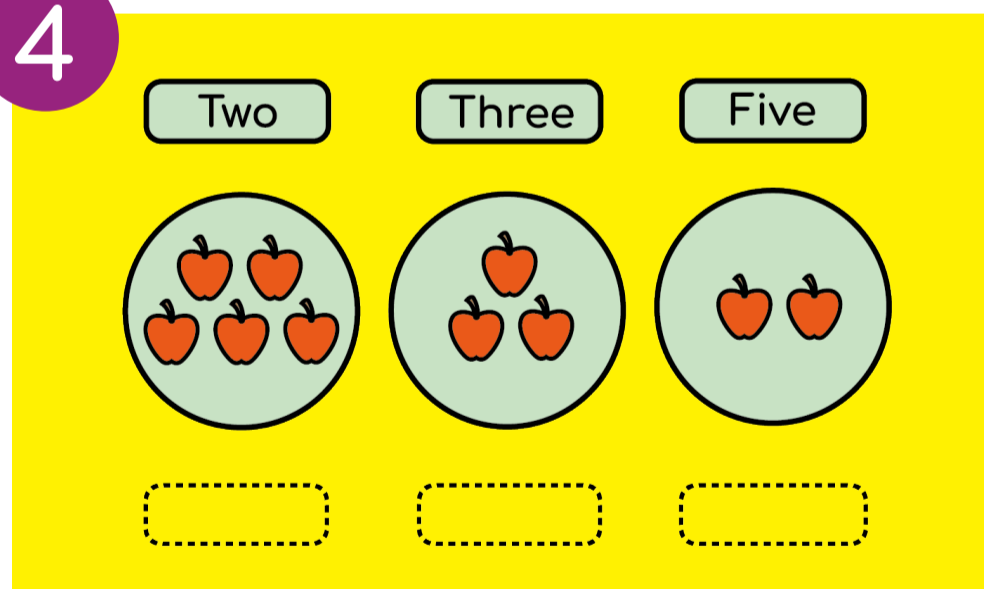
Order numbers from 6 to 10.
